- 3. Nonetheless, the few moments discussion we had was sufficient for me to grasp gist of concerns which prompted your call.
- 4. By now you will have seen a number of cables reflecting this Embassy's position and Doctor Suazo's concerns.
- I note that Tony Quainton is in agreement with our views.
- 5. Perhaps most distressing to me is actual wording of Costa Rican note to OAS which doesn't even make mention of Nicaraguan violations of Costa Rican territory. It is
