- 2. I agree that repeat of San Jose group so soon after October 4 meeting would be artificial. Second, N it might have effect of precluding expansion of membership San Jose group at Foreign Minister or lower level.
- 3. I believe that core CADC group would be the best solution by far. Group would be small enough to be meaningful substantively; these are countries most directly affected by Nicaragua's behavior and the signal couldn't possibly be clearer. In addition I believe meeting with CADC group would provide ideal opportunity for President and publicly to personally/comment on Nicaragua situation along lines
