
In order to help determine my status to assess fees, you should know that I am an individual seeking information for personal use and not for commercial use.

I am aware that if my request is denied, I am entitled to know the grounds for this denial.


I am aware that while the law allows the agency to withhold specified categories of exempted information, it is required by law to release any segregable portions that are left after the exempted material has been deleted from the data I am seeking.

I am aware that the fees for the first 100 pages of duplication in non-commercial FOIA requests are waived. Also, search fees for Privacy Act requests are waived. I am willing to pay fees for this request up to a maximum of \$100.00. If you estimate that the fees will exceed this limit, please inform me first. However, the amended FOIA requires you to reduce or waive search and/or copying fees under certain conditions.
