ublic understanding of the history and performance of the American military intelligence. Thus, I am requesting a full fee waiver. Since my research is certain to stir renewed interest in the DIA, succeeding researchers will desire to examine the documents to ensure veracity and accuracy. Hence, it is unfair for the initial requester to bear the full burden of discovery costs.

As you are well aware, although the law allows for the withholding of specified categories of exempted information, it requires the release of any "segregable" portions of the text which are left after the exempted material is deleted. I will require detailed justification for each such deletion in order to ensure accuracy in my research.

Finally, in the unlikely event that your initial response proves unsatisfactory, please provide me with the name and department of officials who are responsible for appeals.
