SUBJECT: FOREIGN POLITICAL MATTER -
ARGENTINA

Classified "Confidential" because it would disclose FBI interest in a foreign country.

Reference Legat, Buenos Aires, teletype dated 3/16/76.

Lieutenant General Daniel O. Graham, former Director, DIA, was contacted concerning the content of referenced teletype by Supervisor Liaison Officer T. D. J. Brooks, Intelligence Division, on 3/16/76, and he advised that information concerning the Argentine Armed Forces planned coup d'etat in Argentina deposing President Isebel Martinez de Peron came to his attention during his recent visit to Argentina and he had brought this information to the attention of American Ambassador Hill. He stated that while he met Raymond Molina, he did not travel with him to Argentina and, in fact, he traveled there with U. S. Senator Jesse Helms. He stated that he departed Argentina in view of the rumored coup d'etat and felt his presence there would be unwise and added that he has no intention of establishing any contact with Argentine Generals or their representatives either here in the U. S. or abroad.
