① Approach to problem

- a Pres wants to move gradually - diplomatic & military
- b Feeling chances getting men back less if we appear to be presenting a military ultimatum.
- c 1st move thru UN, gain time. Resolution - Pakistan is key - uncertain
- d Push Sovs to use their influence - some movement (I think latest cable overstated; re-read.)
- e Defers call-up of Res & move units to Korea. Short of that, take actions.

 - Extend tours of Service
 - Broaden Pres authority to call individual Reservists
 - \$ | MAP - extra for S. Korea
O&M - \$1 or \$2 billion add-on
 - Extend Korean Emergency Powers?
 - Validation of Presidential powers to req ships, call-up Phase III CRAF, reconsider production priorities now in effect.
