	Mr. Meyer recalled Prime Minister Ben-Gurion's generous agreement in conversation with the President that the United States might use as it wishes the information gained as a result of the recent visit by American scientists to the Dimona reactor, and that a visit by "neutrals" would be acceptable. Pursuant to the Prime Minister's agreement, the Department has "in the works" a quiet indication to the Arabs, through diplomatic channels, of the findings of the scientists. Noting that Mr. Farley is now in Vienna attending the Board of Governors meeting of the IAEA, Mr. Meyer wondered whether the Israel observer at the meeting might not get in touch with Mr. Farley to consider an appropriate announcement of the scientists' visit by the Israel observer at the IAEA conference. In addition, Israel might feel that some useful discussion of a neutral visit to Dimona might be initiated with appropriate, individual respresentatives to the Board of Governors meeting.
