b. The new regime is larded with men who have served in previous Honduran cabinets. Lopez and Colonel Armando Escalon, chief of the air force and new Minister of Defense, are the only military officers holding high positions.

- c. On Saturday Lopez said his government would stay in power about a year, but would not respect any of Villeda's social legislation.
