[redacted] THE WAR PLANT MENTIONED IN REFERENCE REPORTS MAY BE UNDER A CAMP LOCATED ONE KILOMETER WEST OF KOZHUKHOVO (N 55-30, E 36-03) ON THE MOZHAYSK (N 55-30, E 36-01) - MODENOVO (N 55-31, E 36-14) ROAD. THIS CAMP IS AN OFFICERS' CASERNE AND IS FENCED. [redacted] WHO HAS BEEN INSIDE THE WAR PLANT REFERRED TO THE PLANT AS A WAR INSTALLATION LYING UNDERGROUND BENEATH THE CAMP. [redacted] COMMENT: NOTE THAT THIS IS A DIFFERENT LOCATION FROM THE ONE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED.)

2. [redacted] AN ATOMIC ENERGY PLANT IS TO BE CONSTRUCTED SOMEWHERE SOUTHWEST OF THE NAPOLEON MUSEUM BETWEEN BORODINO VILLAGE (N 55-32, E 35-51) AND BORODINO STATION (N 55-30, E 35-52). [redacted] COULD NOT OBSERVE THIS

SITE OR ANY OTHER INSTALLATION OR CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FROM THE VICINITY OF THE MUSEUM BUT SAW A TRAIN RUNNING IN THIS DIRECTION, i. e., SOUTHWEST FROM THE BORODINO STATION. [REDACTED] COMMENT: ACCORDING TO [REDACTED] THE MUSEUM IS AT THE BORODINO STATION, OR AT LEAST NEARER THE STATION THAN THE VILLAGE. IT IS NOT CLEAR WHETHER THE TRAIN [REDACTED] WAS ON THE MAIN MOSCOW-MOZHAYSK-VYAZMA LINE OR WAS ON SOME SIDE LINE.)

3. [REDACTED] A DAM IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN OR BEYOND THE WOODS EAST OF BORODINO VILLAGE BUT COULD NOT OBSERVE THE SITE FROM A POINT TWO KILOMETERS NORTH OF MOZHAYSK. [REDACTED] SAW NO INSTALLATIONS, CONSTRUCTION, OR EXCAVATION IN THE AREA IMMEDIATELY NORTHWEST OF MOZHAYSK.

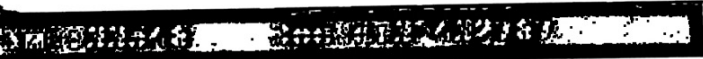
4. NEW ELECTRIC POWER LINES RUN ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF THE MOZHAYSK-MODENOVNO ROAD. THE LINES ARE PARALLEL TO THE ROAD AND ARE LOCATED ONE TO TWO KILOMETERS FROM THE ROAD. THESE LINES RUN AT LEAST AS FAR WEST AS THE WEST SIDE OF THE MOSKVA RIVER NORTH OF MOZHAYSK AND AT LEAST AS FAR EAST AS SHALIKOVA (N 55-30, E 36-12). AT A POINT TWO KILOMETERS NORTH OF MOZHAYSK, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] POWER MASTS RUNNING PARALLEL TO THE MOZHAYSK ROAD IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION (SIC). [REDACTED] COMMENT: IN THE FIRST TWO KILOMETERS, THE ROAD RUNNING NORTH OF MOZHAYSK BENDS FIRST TO NORTHEAST, THEN TO NORTHWEST, THEN STRAIGHTENS OUT IN A NORTH-NORTHWEST DIRECTION. FROM THE ORIGINAL CONTEXT, IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE OBSERVATION POINT [REDACTED] HERE AND IN PARA. 3 AS BEING TWO KILOMETERS NORTH OF MOZHAYSK WAS ACTUALLY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN, AT OR NEAR THE POINT WHERE THE NORTHBOUND ROAD CROSSES THE MOSKVA RIVER. OR BY "MOZHAYSK ROAD" [REDACTED] MEAN THE MOZHAYSK-MODENOVNO ROAD. IF EITHER OF THE LATTER IS THE CASE, IT WOULD APPEAR THAT THE

POWER LINE RUNS THROUGH THE NORTHERN PART OF MOZHAYSK TOWN.) THE ROW OF MASTS DISAPPEARS IN THE WOODS IN THE DIRECTION OF THE DAM SITE MENTIONED IN PARA. 3. EACH MAST CONSISTS OF FOUR STEEL SUPPORTS WHICH FORM A CONE TOWARD THE TOP. THE STEEL SUPPORTS ARE ABOUT TWO METERS APART AT THE BASE OF THE MAST, AND THE MASTS ARE ABOUT TEN METERS HIGH. THE MASTS ARE NEWLY PAINTED A RUST BROWN COLOR AND SOME, APPARENTLY INTENDED FOR FUTURE ERECTION, WERE STILL LYING ON THE GROUND. TWO HEAVY WIRES ARE STRUNG BETWEEN THE MASTS. ELECTRICITY IN MOZHAYSK IS PRODUCED BY GENERATORS LOCATED IN THE TOWN AND SERVICE IS VERY POOR AND FLICKERING. THEREFORE, SOURCE ASSUMES THAT THE ABOVE-MENTIONED POWER LINES DIRECT ELECTRICITY ELSEWHERE AND ARE POSSIBLY CONNECTED WITH THE MOSCOW GRID.

5. [REDACTED] HAD SEEN AN AIRFIELD FOR JET AIRCRAFT ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE MOZHAYSK-MOSCOW HIGHWAY, BETWEEN MOZHAYSK AND THE ZOYA KOSMODEMYANSKAYA STATUE. ON ONE DAY IN EARLY MAY 1957

[REDACTED] SAW NO PLANES IN THE AREA AND DID NOT OBSERVE ANY AIRFIELD ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE ROAD BUT WAS UNABLE TO OBSERVE THE AREA SOUTH OF THE ROAD. [REDACTED] COMMENT: THE ZOYA KOSMODEMYANSKAYA STATUE IS ON THE MOSCOW-MINSK HIGHWAY NEAR DOROKHOVO (N 55-33, E 36-23) AND SEVEN KILOMETERS FROM PEPRELSHIGUEVO (N 55-30, E 36-21).

6. SECURITY CONTROLS ALONG THE HIGHWAY EAST OF MOZHAYSK ARE NOT STRICT.
