DEL WOULD NOT INTRODUCE FORMAL PROPOSALS FOR TREATY AMENDMENTS, MISS AGUIRRE READ PASSAGE FROM AMB CASTANEDA'S SPEECH IN WHICH PROPOSALS WERE DESCRIBED AS INFORMAL SUGGESTIONS. MISS AGUIRRE SAID THAT AMB CASTANEDA HAD LEFT HIS OFFICE EARLY IN AFTERNOON AND SHE WOULD NOT SEE HIM UNTIL TUESDAY. SHE ADDED THAT SUGGESTIONS WERE STRONGLY DESIRED BY MEXICO CITY.
