You are authorized to advise SovDel that we are prepared to accept the changes set forth para 2 reftel in the ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ proposed article on Disarmament; that we can agree to filling in blank in para 3 of Art VI for number of signatories with forty; and that we welcome mutual agreement on revised Art IV, on article regarding nuclear free zones, and on ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ depositaries in para 2 of Art VI.

You should continue press Sovs to accept our proposed Art V language regarding purposes of preamble, periodic review conferences and Preparatory Committee.

Soviet suggestions for revising PNEDs article still under study here.
