3. ON DECEMBER 1, EPA PROPOSED DOMESTIC REGULATIONS TO RESTRICT PRODUCTION AND CONSUMPTION OF OZONE-DEPLETING CHEMICALS. IN ANNOUNCING THE PROPOSED RULE, EPA

ADMINISTRATOR LEE THOMAS NOTED, "THESE RULES WILL FULLY IMPLEMENT THE MONTREAL PROTOCOL TO PROTECT THE STRATOSPHERIC OZONE LAYER. OUR PROPOSAL CONSTITUTES THE AMERICAN RESPONSE TO THE GLOBAL COMMITMENT TO REDUCE THE RISKS OF STRATOSPHERIC OZONE DEPLETION."

- 4. THE PROPOSED REGULATION, BASED ON AN ALLOCATED QUOTA SYSTEM, IS OPEN FOR PUBLIC COMMENT FOR SIXTY DAYS AND IS SCHEDULED TO BE PROMULGATED IN FINAL BY AUGUST 1, 1988. ITS CONTROLS ARE TO TAKE EFFECT ON A SCHEDULE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROTOCOL.
