1. RECOGNIZING THAT THE AIM OF THE UNITED NATIONS IN THE FIELD OF DISARMAMENT IS AN EFFECTIVE GENERAL AGREEMENT ON THE PROHIBITION OF ATOMIC, HYDROGEN AND OTHER WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION WHICH WILL PROVIDE FOR THE CESSATION OF THE PRODUCTION OF SUCH WEAPONS, THE DESTRUCTION OF EXISTING STOCKS AND FOR THE PROGRESSIVE LIMITATION OF CONVENTIONAL ARMAMENTS,

RECOGNIZING FURTHER THAT THE DANGER NOW EXISTS THAT AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF STATES POSSESSING NUCLEAR WEAPONS MAY AGGRAVATE INTERNATIONAL TENSION AND THE DIFFICULTY OF MAINTAINING WORLD PEACE, THUS RENDERING MORE DIFFICULT THE ATTAINMENT OF THE GENERAL DISARMAMENT AGREEMENT ENVISAGED IN PARAGRAPH 1,

AND UNDERTAKE THAT THEY SHALL NOT SUPPLY NUCLEAR WEAPONS TO ANY OTHER STATE, AND THAT THEY SHALL NOT SUPPLY TO ANY OTHER STATE ANY EQUIPMENT OR INFORMATION OR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENABLING ANOTHER STATE TO PRODUCE NUCLEAR WEAPONS OF ANY KIND,

5. CALLS UPON ALL OTHER STATES TO DECLARE AND UNDERTAKE  THAT THEY SHALL NOT PRODUCE NUCLEAR WEAPONS OF ANY KIND OR SEEK TO OBTAIN SUCH WEAPONS FROM ANY STATE WHICH POSSESSE THEM,

6. INVITES STATES WHICH ARE NOT MEMBERS OF THE UNITED NATIONS TO JOIN IN THE DECLARATION AND UNDERTAKING REFERRED TO IN THE FOREGOING PARAGRAPH,

7. DECIDES TO ESTABLISH AN AD HOC COMMITTEE OF (BLANK) MEMBERS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DRAFTING WITHOUT DELAY THE DECLARATIONS AND UNDERTAKING REFERRED TO IN PARAGRAPHS 4, 5 AND 6 OF THIS RESOLUTION, AND TO PREPARE FOR CONSIDERATION AT THE FOURTEENTH SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY A DRAFT CONVENTION EMBODYING THE PRINCIPLES OF PARAGRAPHS 4 AND 5 OF THIS RESOLUTION AND CONTAINING APPROPRIATE PROVISIONS FOR INSPECTION AND CONTROL,

8. REQUESTS THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO SUBMIT THE TEXTS OF THE DECLARATIONS AND UNDERTAKINGS DRAFTED BY THE AD HOC COMMITTEE TO THE GOVERNMENTS CONCERNED AS SOON AS THEY ARE AVAILABLE AND TO INVITE THEM TO MAKE KNOWN THE ACTION THEY PROPOSE TO TAKE, BEFORE MARCH 1ST 1959. UNQUOTE
