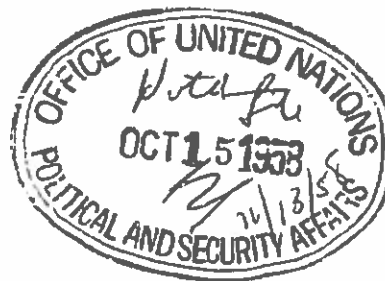

VERBATIM TEXT

RE: DISARMAMENT

FOLLOWING IS LATEST DRAFT IRISH DISARMAMENT RESOLUTION GIVEN US BY AIKEN TODAY:

"THE GA

"1. RECOGNIZING THAT THE AIM OF THE UNITED NATIONS IN THE FIELD OF DISARMAMENT IS AN EFFECTIVE GENERAL AGREEMENT ON THE PROHIBITION OF ATOMIC, HYDROGEN AND OTHER WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION WHICH WILL PROVIDE FOR THE CESSATION OF THE PRODUCTION OF SUCH WEAPONS, THE DESTRUCTION OF EXISTING STOCKS AND THE PROGRESSIVE LIMITATION OF CONVENTIONAL ARMAMENTS,

"2. RECOGNIZING FURTHER THAT THE DANGER NOW EXISTS THAT AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF STATES POSSESSING NUCLEAR WEAPONS MAY OCCUR AGGRAVATING INTERNATIONAL TENSION AND THE DIFFICULTY OF MAINTAINING WORLD PEACE AND THUS RENDERING MORE DIFFICULT THE ATTAINMENT OF THE GENERAL DISARMAMENT AGREEMENT ENVISAGED IN PARAGRAPH 1,

"3. DECIDES TO ESTABLISH AN AD HOC COMMISSION TO STUDY THE DANGERS INHERENT IN THE FURTHER DISSEMINATION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS, AND RECOMMEND TO THE FOURTEENTH SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY APPROPRIATE MEASURES FOR AVERTING THESE DANGERS."
