SECRETARY BY AIKEN:

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

NEA DCL

- 1. RECOGNIZING THE DANGER THAT AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF STATES POSSESSING NUCLEAR WEAPONS MAY OCCUR, AGGRAVATING INTERNATION -AL TENSIONS AND THE DIFFICULTY OF MAINTAINING WORLD PEACE AND TOUR RENDERING MORE DIFFICULT THE ATTAINMENT OF GENERAL DISARMAMENT AGREEMENT,
- 2. CONVINCED THEREFORE THAT CONSIDERATION OF THIS DANGER IS APPROPRIATE WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF DELIBERATIONS ON DISARMAMENT,
- DESIRING TO BRING TO THE ATTENTION OF THE POWERS CONCERNED IN THE CONSULTATIONS AGREED UPON BY THE FOREIGN MINISTERS! CONFERENCE IN GENEVA LAST AUGUST ITS CONVICTION THAT CONSIDERA-TION SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THIS PROBLEM,
- 4. SUGGESTS THAT IN THE COURSE OF THE SAID CONSULTATIONS CONSIDERATION SHOULD BE GIVEN TO APPROPRIATE MEANS WHEREBY THISE: DANGER MAY BE AVERTED, AND WITH THIS END IN VIEW, EXAMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF ARRIVING AT AN INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENT, SUBJECT \$2 TO INSPECTION AND CONTROL, WHEREBY THE POWERS PRODUCING NUCLEAR WE APONS WOULD REFRAIN FROM HANDING OVER THE CONTROL OF SUCH WEAPONS TO ANY NATION NOT POSSESSING THEM AND WHEREBY THE POWER NOT POSSESSING SUCH WEAPONS WOULD REFRAIN FROM MANUFACT THEM.
