Irish Resolution; USUN 1523

US delegation officer discussed with Ronan (Ireland today's status Irish resolution. Rather hesitantly Ronan said he now awaiting final instructions but able indicate following:

- (1) Aiken could accept deletion operative paragraph 1, since appeared in preamble.
- (2) In operative paragraph two word "control" not after "accept" had been changed to "possession".
- (3) Operative paragraph three being redrafted so as to make control provisions applicable only to non-nuclear states. Department will recall previous Ronan statement (USUN 1316) that difficulty with making both nuclear and non-nuclear powers subject to measures inspection and control was that nuclear powers unable agree on what these measures should be and thus any action precluded.

Ronan said, present inclination was to circulate resolution soon as final instructions received. US delegation officer requested be informed final text prior submission, indicating word "possession" in operative paragraph two would present difficulties.
