She stated Duke will provide all of the assistance possible. Should a university computer need to be seized, a subpoena/court order or search warrant should be directed to her at 2400 Pratt Street, Suite 4000, Durham, N.C. 27710. If the computer in question is identified as the private property of one of the students, then the subpoena (etc.) should be directed to the student. In that case, she would request an information copy be provided or, at least shown to, her.

[redacted] advised that it is fairly standard practice of the different departments at Duke to periodically erase or purge all of the computers in their departments at one time in order to avoid data overload and the consequent slowing down of their operation.
