

JTF Computer Network Defense



- DISA selected as host for Joint Task Force Computer Network Defense, 23 Jul 98
 - SECDEF signed Charter on 4 Dec 98; IOC by 31 Dec 98; FOC 180 days after IOC
- CONOPS defines following tasks to JTF:
 - Monitor ops, incidents, vulnerabilities, threats
 - Coordinate with DoD, Gov't agencies, & private sector
 - Perform attack assessments

- Develop protection plans & procedures
- Participate in joint exercises
- Direct actions to stop, contain, & limit attack damage

Will not initiate offensive action

- 4 other AF personnel designated
 - All Majors (J2, J3/6, J5/7)
- AFFOR is AFCERT and COMAFFOR is the AFIWC/CC
 - Coordinates w/ AFNOC & AFOSI
- UCP change will transfer JTF-CND from SECDEF to USSPACE, probably Oct 99
 - Future location of JTF is TBD
 - Under USSPACE, JTF slated to assume offensive and defensive responsibilities



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
