GRATITUDE FOR THE AFFIRMATIVE APPROACH SET FORTH IN THE PRESIDENT'S LETTER TO THATCHER. THEY UNDERSTOOD QUE DESIRE FOR DELAY IN THE DECISION-MAKING PROCESS AND WILL WORK TO ACCOMMODITAL US.

- 2. JOHN HUNT EXPLAINED THAT BRITISH HAD HOPED TO TAKE A CABINET DECISION ON POLARIS MODERNIZATION IN EARLY NOVEMBER WHICH THEY WOULD CONVEY TO US SHORTLY THEREAFTER BUT WITHOUT REQUESTING A RESPONSE. PRIME MINISTER THATCHER HAD PLANNED TO MAKE A FORMAL REQUEST WHEN SHE MET WITH THE PRESIDENT IN DECEMBER.
- I EXPRESSED CONCERN THAT A DECISION TAKEN IN EARLY NOVEMBER WOULD NOT KEEP UNTIL MID-DECEMBER. MOREOVER, THE PRESIDENT WANTED TO DISCUSS THE TIMING OF A FORMAL REQUEST AND OF OUR RESPONSE WHEN HE MEETS WITH THATCHER IN DECEMBER. WHILE WE COULD NOT PRESCRIBE THE BRITISH DECISION PROCESS, I URGED THAT THEY CONSIDER DELAYING THEIR OWN DECISION AS LONG AS POSSIBLE.
- 4. LATER, WADE GERY SAID HE UNDERSTOOD THAT THEY SHOULD NOT COUNT ON MAKING A REQUEST AT THE THATCHER/CARTER MEETING BUT HE SAID THE PRIME MINISTER MIGHT NEED TO TAKE AT LEAST AN INTITIAL DECISION AMONGST HER "INNER CABINET" PRIOR TO HER VISIT TO WASHINGTON. HE ACSO SAID THAT HE THOUGHT THEY COULD STAGE."
