LESSON LEARNED:

FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS DISCUSSION, CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:

A. THE U.S. HAS FOUR KINDS OF ASSETS AVAILABLE FOR DEALING WITH TERRORIST ACTIVITIES OCONUS, I.E.:

- 1. THE EST A SMALL GROUP OF HIGH-LEVEL EXPERTS (STATE, CIA, JSOC, FBI, NEST, COMMUNICATIONS, ETC.) WHOSE FUNCTION IS TO EVALUATE A SITUATION AND COORDINATE U.S. ACTION).
- 2. JSOC- THE U.S. STRIKE FORCE.
- 3. NEST THE U.S. NUCLEAR ANTI-TERRORIST TECHNICAL CAPABILITY.
- 4. DOD CINC AREA COMMANDERS AND THEIR ASSETS.
- B. IN RESPONSE TO A SPECIFIC TERRORIST ACTIVITY, THE EST AND JSOC ASSETS ARE "SURGICAL FORCES" THEY GO IN FAST, WITH AS LOW A PROFILE AS IS POSSIBLE, DO THEIR THING, AND PULL OUT QUICKLY. THEY ARE NOT LONG-TERM RESIDENT ASSETS AT AN INCIDENT SITE, NOR IS THE JSOC IN ANY USUAL MILITARY SENSE A SECURITY OR FIGHTING FORCE. THEY ARE "JUMPERS, STICKERS, AND SHOOTERS."
- C. THE NEST ASSETS, IF THEY ARE DEPLOYED OCONUS, MAY BE ABLE TO COM-PLETE THEIR ACTIVITIES ON THE SAME TIME SCALE AS EST AND JSOC , USUALLY THEY WILL NOT. IF THEY DO NOT, AND EST AND JSOC MUST LEAVE, NEST DOES NOT HAVE RESOURCES TO PROVIDE FOR ITS OWN SECURITY.
- D. IF THE EST AND JSOC- ASSETS MUST LEAVE, AND THE INCIDENT SITE IS WITHIN THE JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES OF A U.S.-CINC AREA COMMANDER. RESPONSIBILITY FOR SECURITY OF NEST ASSETS MAY BE PASSED TO THAT COMMANDER.
- E. IF THE INCIDENT SITE DOES NOT LIE WITHIN A US-CINC COMMAND, THE U.S. MUST EITHER SEND IN ADDITIONAL U.S. SECURITY FORCES OR RELY ON THE SECURITY FORCES OF THE HOST COUNTRY.

LESSONS:

- 1. ON ANY OCONUS DEPLOYMENT OF EST-JSOC -NEST ASSETS, IT MUST BE ASSUMED THAT EST-JSOC- ASSETS WILL DEPART THE INCIDENT SITE AS SOON AS THE JSOC- ACTIVITIES ARE COMPLETED.
- 2. AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IN THE INCIDENT TIME-LINE, AN ESTIMATE SHOULD BE MADE OF THE LENGTH OF TIME THAT NEST ASSETS WILL BE NEEDED AT THE INCIDENT SITE. IF THAT TIME GOES BEYOND THE DEPARTURE TIME OF EST-JSOC- AN EARLY, CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD DETERMINATION MUST BE MADE WITH THE HOST COUNTRY AS TO WHO WILL PROVIDE SECURITY TO U.S. ASSETS DURING THIS PERIOD.
