- 2. FOLLOWING IS INFORMATION REQUESTED REFTEL ON COLOMBIAN COUNTER-TERRORISM UNITS. WHILE THE PROLIFERATION OF MILITARY AND POLICE SPECIAL UNITS SUGGESTS CONSIDERABLE OVERLAPPING OF EFFORT AND POTENTIAL CONFLICTS, IN PRACTICE THE SENIOR LOCAL COLOMBIAN ARMY OFFICIAL HAS ASSUMED COMMAND IN SERIOUS TERRORIST INCIDENTS. AS EXAMPLES, THE COMMANDER OF BOGOTA'S MILITARY INSTITUTES BRIGADE (BIM) TOOK RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMBINED SECURITY OPERATIONS AT THE TIME OF THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC EMBASSY HOSTAGE SITUATION, AND THE COMMANDER OF THE 3RD BRIGADE IN CALI TOOK CHARGE DURING LAST JANUARY'S AEROTAL AIRPLANE HIJACKING IN THAT CITY.



THE COLOMBIAN ARMY HAS A "SPECIAL FORCES UNIT"
(UNIDAD DE FUERZAS ESPECIALES) WHICH INCLUDES
APPROXIMATELY 15 OFFICERS AND 40 NCO'S. THE UNIT CAN
BE USED IN IMMEDIATE RESPONSE TO TERRORIST INCIDENTS,

(2) ANTI-KIDNAPPING AND EXTORTION COMMAND

THE COMANDO ANTI SECUESTRO Y EXTORCION (CAIS) IS COMPOSED OF FIVE ARMY OFFICERS AND 12 ARMY NCO'S, AND 20 OFFICIALS ASSIGNED TO THE UNIT FROM THE NATIONAL POLICE AND DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SECURITY. THE UNIT IS UNDER THE DIRECTITY OF A MAJOR OF THE COLOMBIAN ARMY. THE OFFICIALS OF THE NATIONAL POLICE AND DAS INCLUDE SPECIALISTS IN EXPLOSIVES DEACTIVATION, TECHNICIANS FOR IDENTIFICATION BY BLOOD TYPE AND FINGERPRINTS, EXPERTS IN PASSPORT AND DOCUMENT FALSIFICATION, ANDJMALE AND FEMALE SURVEILLANTS. ALTHOUGH ARMY PERSONNEL ARE EXPECTED TO BE FAMILIAR WITH ALL ARMS AVAILABLE TO THE COLOMBIAN ARMY, POLICE AND DAS OFFICIALS ARE ONLY ASSIGNED AND FAMILIAR WITH PISTOLS, REVOLVERS AND SUBMACHINE GUNS. HAS NOT RECEIVED SPECIALIZED TRAINING.

THE RESPECTIVE COMMANDERS IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF COLOMBIA. THE GOES PERSONNEL (OFFICERS, NCO'S AND AGENTS) ARE CHOSEN FROM AMONG THE BETTER QUALIFIED MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL POLICE. THEY ARE EQUIPPED WITH UZI SUBMACHINE GUNS, INGRAMS, G-3 RIFLES, AND GAS AND ANTI-PERSONNEL GRENADES. EACH MEMBER OF THE UNIT IS CAPABLE OF HANDLING ANY OF THE WEAPONS ASSIGNED TO THE UNIT. THE COMMANDERS OF THE GOES UNITS HAVE RECEIVED INSTRUCTION IN SPAIN, AND THE TRAINING WAS DESIGNED TO PERMIT THEM TO INSTRUCT THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE GROUP. THE BOGOTA DETACHMENT OF THE GOES CONSISTS OF 15 MEN AND IS PRESENTLY ORGANIZING SIMILAR GROUPS IN OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY.

THE NATIONAL POLICE ANTI-EXPLOSIVES UNIT INCLUDES APPROXIMATELY 45 SPECIALLY TRAINED TECHNICIANS LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. EACH EXPLOSIVES DEACTIVATION UNIT ROTATES THREE SPECIALISTS FOR 24-HOUR RESPONSE CAPABILITY. THIS UNIT HAS RECEIVED TRAINING IN THE UNITED STATES; AND FROM ISRAEL IN BOGOTA. THE LAST COURSE GIVEN BY ISRAELI SPECIALISTS, WHO TRAVELLED TO BOGOTA, WAS APPROXIMATELY IN AUGUST 1982.

UNITS HAVE BEEN TRAINED TO RESPOND TO TERRORIST INCIDENTS OF ALL TYPES, INCLUDING SEIZURE OF AIRCRAFT, BUILDINGS, BOATS, TRAINS, AND IN HOSTAGE SITUATIONS. THEY HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED AGAINST ACTUAL TERRORIST SITUATIONS WHICH HAVE INCLUDED KIDNAPPINGS AND AIRCRAFT HIJACKINGS, AND THE EXPLOSIVES UNIT HAS DEACTIVATED NUMEROUS EXPLOSIVES OF ALL TYPES.



- THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC ORDER, UNDER THE COMMAND OF RETIRED MAJOR CARLOS GARCIA VARGAS, WAS FORMED OVER TEN YEARS AGO. ITS PRESENT COMPLEMENT INCLUDES APPROXIMATELY 100 MEN EQUIPPED WITH HANDGUNS AND SUBMACHINE GUNS (UZI, INGRAM, MP5).

- THE IMMEDIATE RESPONSE GROUP (GRUPO DE REACCIONES INMEDIATE), UNDER THE COMMAND OF DR. JUAN MANUEL MEDELLIN, CONSISTS OF APPROXIMATELY 90 PERSONS, AND EMPLOYS 30 ON ACTIVE DUTY FOR 24 HOURS AND OFF FOR 48 HOURS.
- BOTH OF THE ABOVE UNITS WOULD RESPOND TO A TERRORIST INCIDENT, ALTHOUGH THE DAS DOES NOT HAVE A SPECIALLY-TRAINED ANTI-TERRORIST UNIT. IN 1980 DAS PERSONNEL RECEIVED TRAINING IN TERRORIST INCIDENT MANAGEMENT, AND PARTICIPATED IN THE COLOMBIAN GOVERNMENT'S RESPONSE TO THE SEIZURE OF THE DOMINICAN EMBASSY BY THE M-19. PERSONNEL WHO RECEIVED THIS TRAINING SUBSEQUENTLY WERE TRANSFERRED TO OTHER POSTS.
