(G/NF) - AT APPROXIMATELY 1500R ON 851106 COLOMBIAN SECURITY FORCES ASSAULTED THE PALACE JUSTICE BUILDING AND REGAINED CONTROL OF FOUR OF FIVE FLOORS IN THE BUILDING, GOVERNMENT LOSSES WERE 1 KIA AND 2 WIA.
