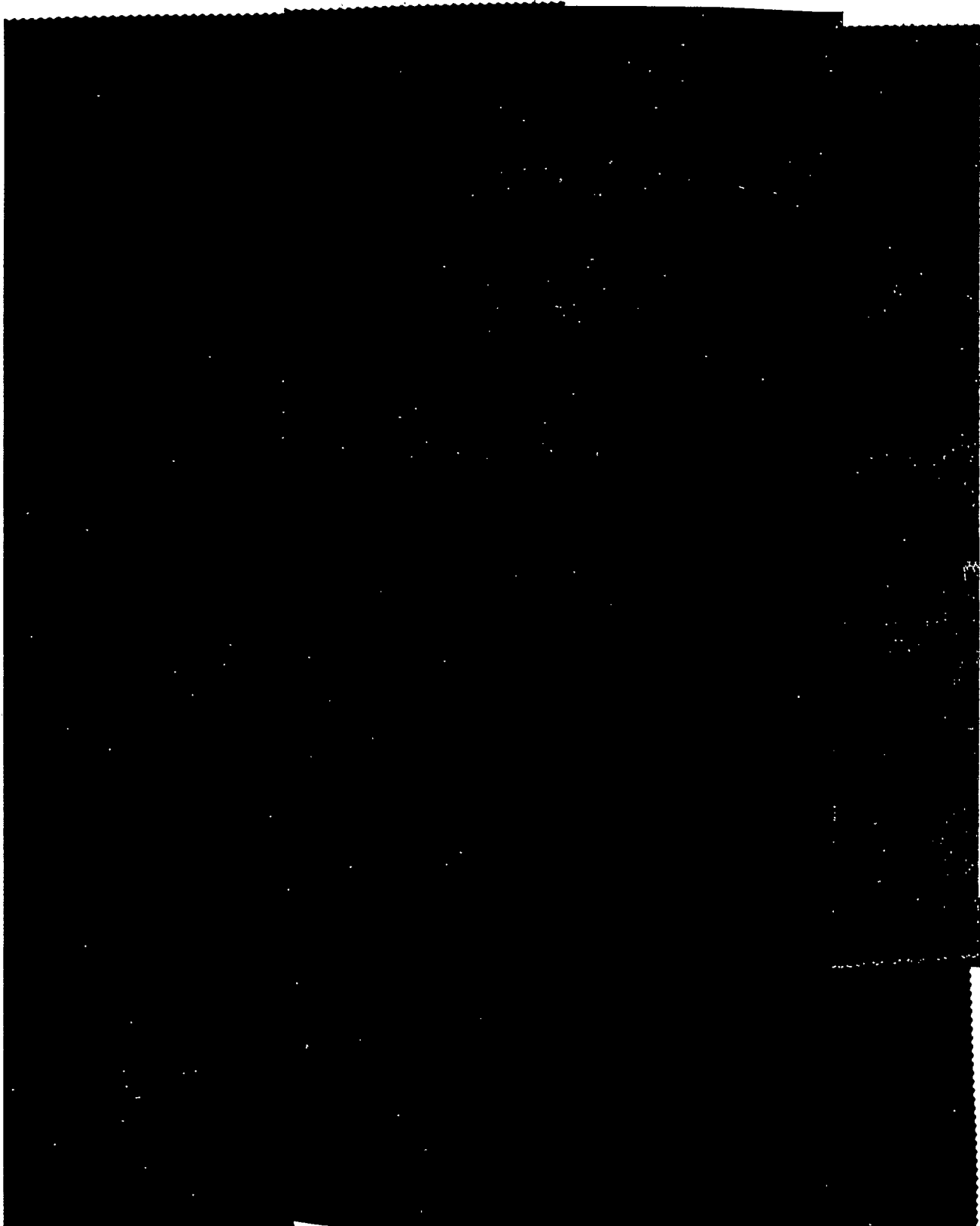

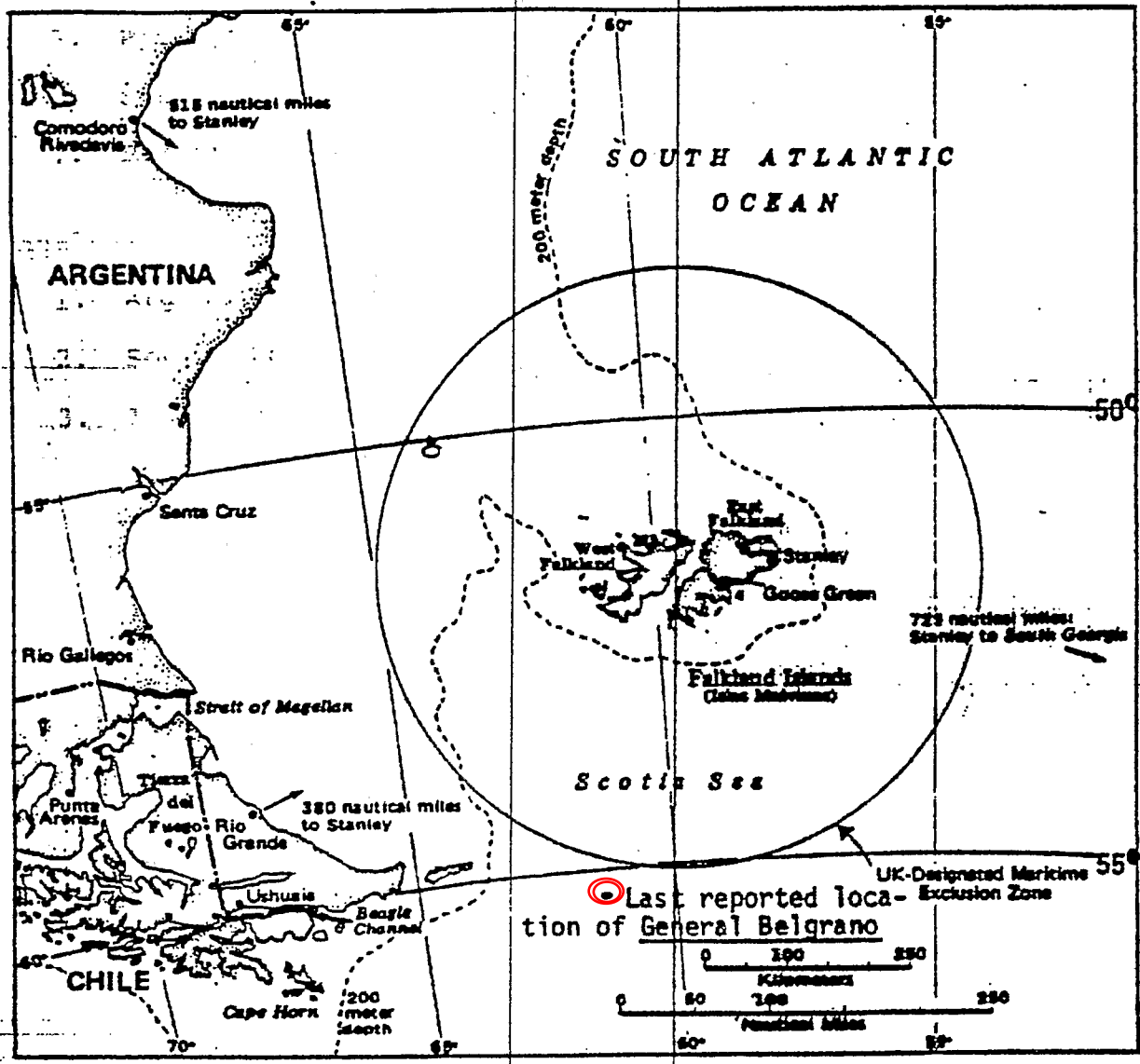

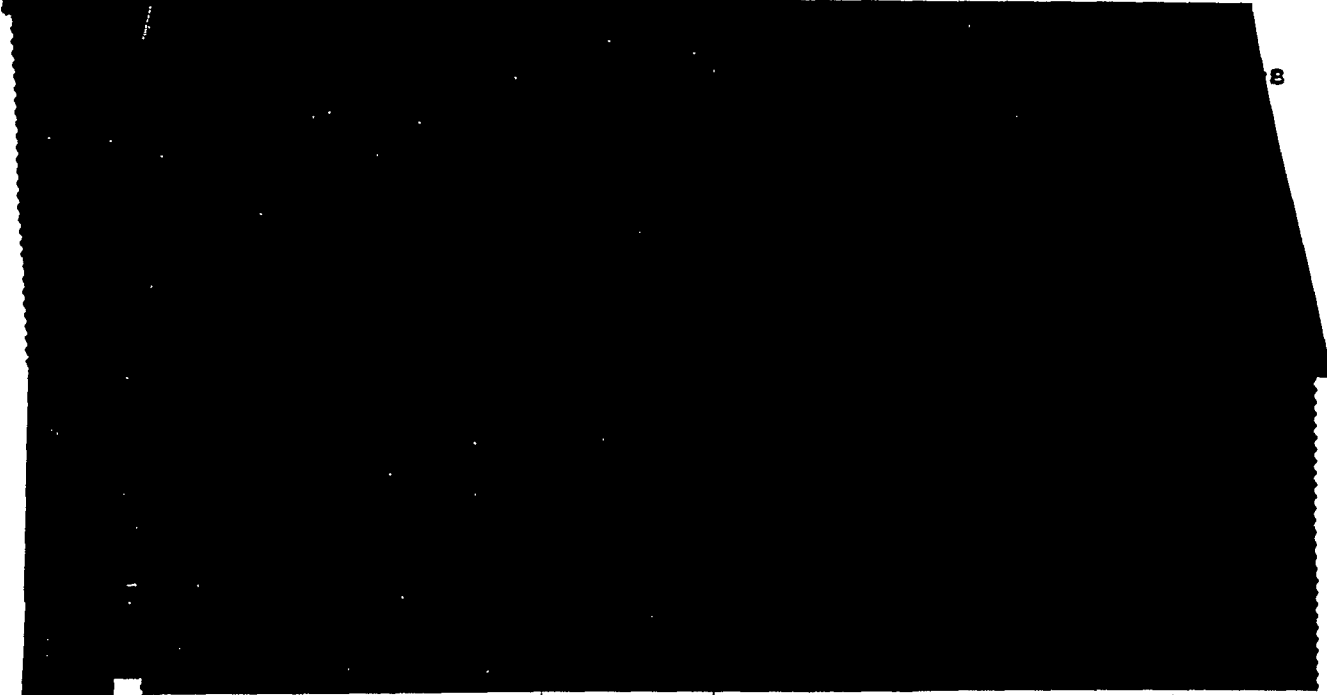

4. ARGENTINA: THE NEIGHBORS' ATTITUDES

A. Peru Sees Little Prospect for Diplomatic Solution

Peruvian Prime Minister Ulloa told Ambassador Ortiz the Argentines had been receptive to the seven point Peruvian proposal, but news of the Belgrano sinking had ended serious consideration of it. He would not recommend further action by Peru without reasonable assurance from the British that the attempt would not be sabotaged. Ulloa added that Venezuela is now pressing other Latin countries to break diplomatic relations with Great Britain. (CONFIDENTIAL/EXDIS)



5. PORTUGAL DENIES US REQUEST FOR AZORES TRANSIT

The Portuguese government denied a US request for two F-4E's to transit Lajes Air Base in the Azores on their way to Egypt last week.
