VIEW BEN GURION'S RESIGNATION, ASSUME PRES WILL WISH RE-
CONSIDER WHETHER LETTER TEXT OF WHICH CONTAINED REFTEL
SHOULD BE CONVEYED TO HIM OR REDRAFTED FOR ADDRESS TO
SUCCESSOR.

ALTHOUGH I APPRECIATE THAT MATTER OF EARLY VISIT DIMONEUIS#
ONE OF HIGH PRIORITY FOR US, MOST UNLIKELY WE CAN GET FURTHER
EAR OF CABINET ON THIS QUESTION WHILE CURRENT POLITICAL
CRISIS UNRESOLVED. WOULD, THEREFORE, RECOMMEND APPROACH BE
POSTPONED UNTIL CABINET PROBLEM IS SORTED OUT AND DEMARCHE CAN
BE RETAILORED, IF NECESSARY, TO NEW INCUMBENT PRIME MINISTER'S
OFFICE. INCIDENTALLY, MAY BE NOTED THAT, WHILE PROBABLY NOT
A MAJOR CAUSE OF DISSENSION, THIS ISSUE WAS ITSELF NOT WITH-
OUT CONTROVERSY WHEN BEN-GURION PRESENTED IT TO HIS COLLEAGUES
BEFORE DISPATCH HIS LETTER MAY 27.
