SUBJECT: NATO NUCLEAR PLANNING GROUP: WHAT HAPPENED AT ANKARA.

1. THE ANKARA MEETING OF THE NUCLEAR PLANNING GROUP PROVIDED FURTHER EVIDENCE OF USEFULNESS OF THE TECHNIQUES WE ARE
USING FOR NUCLEAR CONSULTATION. ONCE AGAIN MINISTERS SHOWED
EVERY EVIDENCE OF HAVING DONE THEIR HOMEWORK. THERE WAS A TOTAL
ABSENCE OF LONG PREPARED SPEECHES. THERE WAS SOME REAL ACCOMMODATION OF CONFLICTING VIEWS AND INTERESTS (DELEGATION STAFFS
WORKED UNTIL 2 AM ON MINUTES AND COMMUNIQUE). AND NOTABLE PROGRESS
IN MOVING TOWARD SYSTEMATIC NATO NUCLEAR PLANS. TEXTS OF AGREED
MINUTE AND COMMUNIQUE ARE IN ANKARA 1587 AND 1586.

2. SECRETARY MCNAMARA'S THEME, REPEATED SEVERAL TIMES IN
DIFFERENT WAYS, WAS THAT WITH 7,000 NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN EUROPE,
WE URGENTLY NEED AGREED STRATEGY AND PLANS FOR PRACTICAL WAYS
OF USING THEM FOR DEFENSE-WITHOUT SUCH PLANS, THEIR DETERRENT
VALUE IS COMPROMISED. HE THEREFORE URGED HIS COLLEAGUES TO
MOVE RAPIDLY TOWARD MORE CONCRETE OPERATIONAL PLANS FOR SPECIFIC
NUCLEAR WEAPONS SYSTEMS IN DEFINED CONTINGENCIES IN PARTICULAR
GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS. IN THE COURSE OF THE MEETING, HE PROPOSED
A PLANNING CYCLE WHICH, AFTER SOME FURTHER DISCUSSION WITHIN
NATO, CAN PROBABLY BECOME A VEHICLE FOR A SYSTEMATIC NATO
NUCLEAR PLANNING SYSTEM AND THE OCCASION FOR CONTINUOUS
GENERATION OF NUCLEAR POLICY GUIDANCE BY NPG MINISTERS AS WE
GO ALONG.

3. PROBLEM OF ADMS IN TURKEY WAS IN EFFECT TAKEN AS THE FIRST EXAMPLE OF THIS KIND OF PLANNING. MINISTERS AGREED THAT "UNDER FAVORABLE CONDITIONS, THE USE OF ADMS MIGHT HAVE SIGNIFICANT MILITARY ADVANTAGES AS COMPARED WITH CONVENTIONAL EXPLOSIVES AS PART OF A COMPREHENSIVE DEFENSIVE SYSTEM IN THE MOUNTAINOUS TERRAIN OF EASTERN TURKEY." THEY WENT ON FROM

THERE TO ASK SACEUR TO PREPARE BY THE END OF THIS YEAR DETAILED

A. THE FRG ANALYSIS (ALREADY DONE IN PART) OF THE-USE OF ADMS IN GERMANY;

FROM THESE DETAILED PLANS TO WHICH THE TACTICAL NUCLEAR STUDIES SHOULD LEAD, AND THEIR CASE-BY-CASE REVIEW BY THE NATIONS CONCERNED AND BY THE MILITARY COMMITTEE, NPG CAN AND SHOULD DERIVE MORE AND MORE SOPHISTICATED POLITICAL GUIDANCE TO BE PROVIDED TO THE NATO MILITARY AUTHORITIES. THIS PROCESS SHOULD FURTHER THE EDUCATION OF A GROW ING NUMBER OF POLITICALLY RESPONSIBLE OFFICIALS IN NATO GOVERNMENTS: WE ARE COMMENTING IN A COMPANION MESSAGE ON HOW FAR THIS HAS ALREADY GONE, AND HOW FAR THERE IS TO GO. THE NUCLEAR PLANNING CYCLE WE NOW ENVISAGE SHOULD ALSO PUT THE NATO COMMANDS AND THE NATIONAL MILITARY AUTHORITIES MORE CLOSELY IN TOUCH, IN A MORE DOWN-TO-EARTH LEVEL OF DISCOURSE, WITH THE KINDS OF POLITICAL AUTHORITIES THEY WOULD BE ADVISING IN AN ACTUAL NUCLEAR EMERGENCY, AND THUS WITH THE KINDS OF QUESTIONS NATIONAL POLITICAL LEADERS/MUST ASK TO SATISFY THEIR OWN DOMESTIC CONSTITUENCIES.



MAIN AT FRG URGING. THE MILITARY COMMITTEE WAS ASKED TO LOOK AGAIN AT NATIONAL PARTICIPATION IN MILITARY NUCLEAR PLANNING AT THE "LEVEL OF MAJOR NATO COMMANDS AND MAJOR SUBORDINATE COMMANDS". THE NPG PERMREPS WERE ASKED TO STUDY (I) "THE QUESTION OF LIAISON WITH US NATIONAL NUCLEAR PLANNING BODIES." AND 8II) HOW TO USE THE NDAC/NPG SETUP ITSELF "TO SATISFY THE NEED FOR FULLER NATIONAL PARTICIPATION."

8. THE CONFUSION AND FRUSTRATION BETRAYED BY THESE VAGUE CALLS FOR MORE NATIONAL PARTICIPATION IN NUCLEAR PLANNING CAN BE "SATISFIED" ONLY BY A SYSTEM IN WHICH THE NATO NATIONS CAN FEEL THEIR WORRIES (EVEN IF ILL-INFORMED) WILL GET A RESPONSIBLE HEARING. THE SECDEF PROPOSAL SHOULD PROVIDE THE ANSWER TO THESE FRUSTRATIONS, AND USG TREATMENT OF THESE INTERRELATED PROCEDURAL ASSIGNMENTS WILL NEED TO BE CONSISTENT WITH THE AIM OF GETTING SOMETHING SIMILAR TO THE SECDEF CONCEPT ESTABLISHED.

9° THIS NEW KIND OF NUCLEAR PLANNING IS A POTENTIALLY MAJOR DEVELOPMENT IN NATO. TO BE FULLY RESPONSIVE. WE WILL ALL NEED TO DEVOTE TO IT THE EFFORT, ATTENTION AND QUALITY STAFF WORK IT DESERVES.
