Subject: British Guiana

At a meeting this afternoon between Mr. Johnson and Mr. Helms it was agreed that we would propose to the British a specific agenda for the talks next week on British Guiana. The objective is to bring matters to a head by forcing a consideration of political factors



The agenda is as follows:

1. Assessment of the situation in British Guiana.
2. Nature of a successor government to Jagan.
