MEMORANDUM TO: Mr. Schlesinger

SUBJECT: British Guiana

I may not catch you in the rush before I get away tomorrow, and I want to tell you the situation on British Guiana. David Ormsby Gore has brought in the Prime Minister's answer with a most stringent personal request from the Prime Minister

The answer is satisfactory, but the President has asked that its exact character not be put on paper anywhere. He has also asked that it be kept away from the State Department [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] So we are not cluing the State Department below the highest levels, and we are all enjoined by the President to keep out of it ourselves other than for the transmission of traffic to those who are directly concerned.

What I think this means is that you have won an argument and lost an assignment.
