The answer is satisfactory, but the President has asked that its exact character not be put on paper anywhere. He has also asked that it be kept away from the State Department


Department below the highest levels, and we are all enjoined by the President to keep out of it ourselves other than for the transmission of traffic to those who are directly concerned.
