Summary

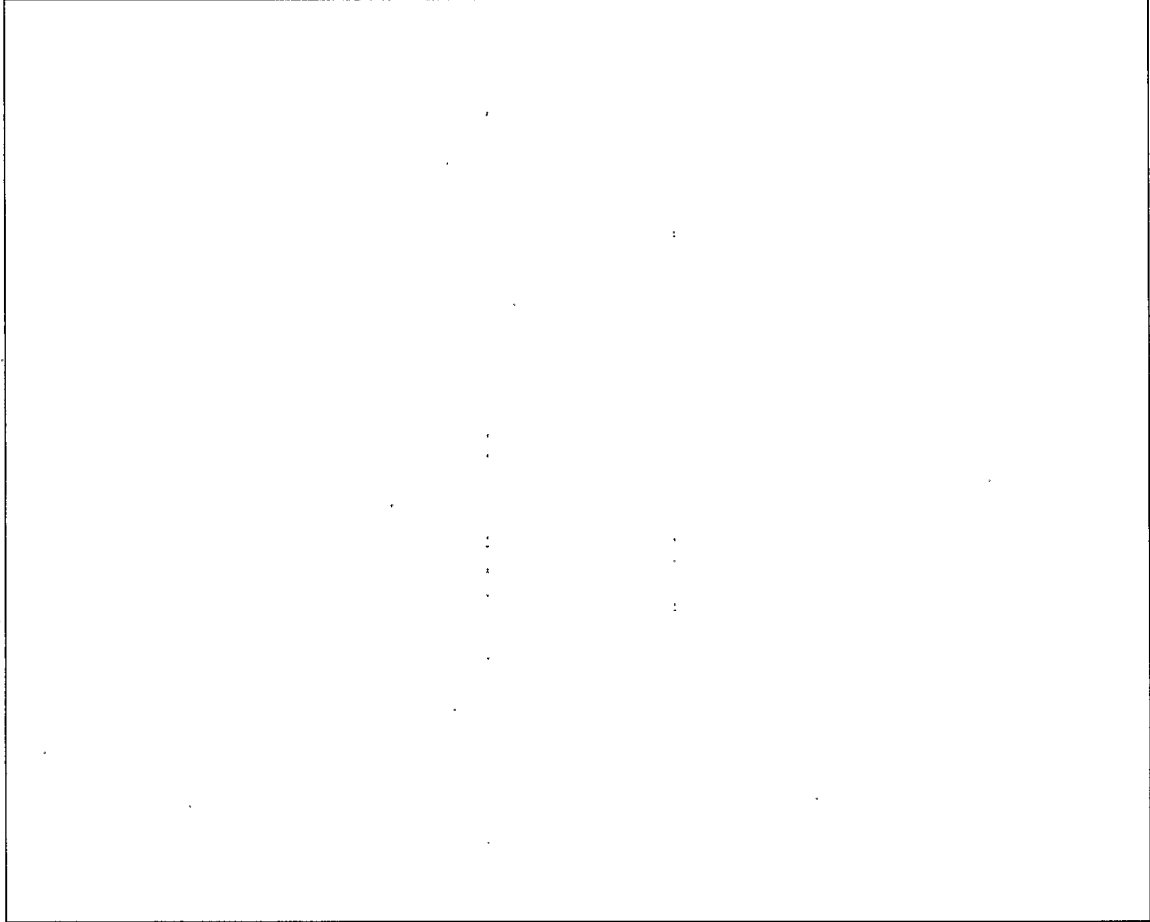

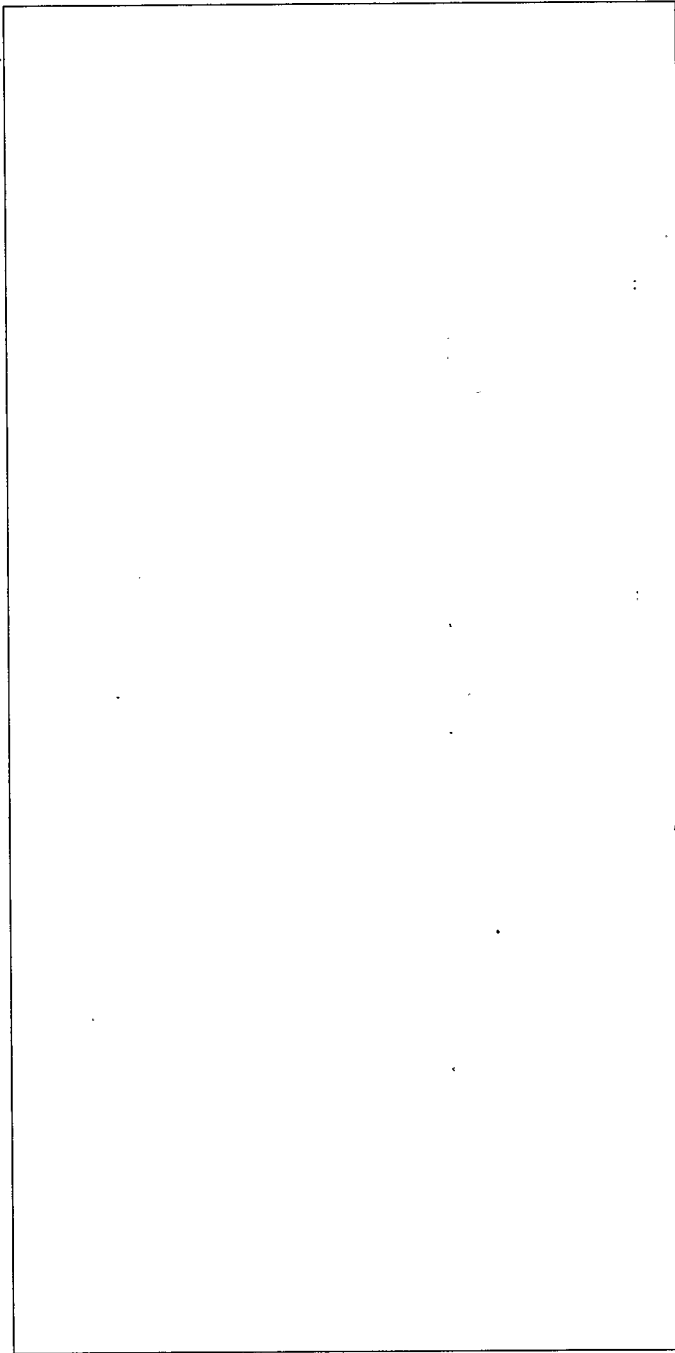

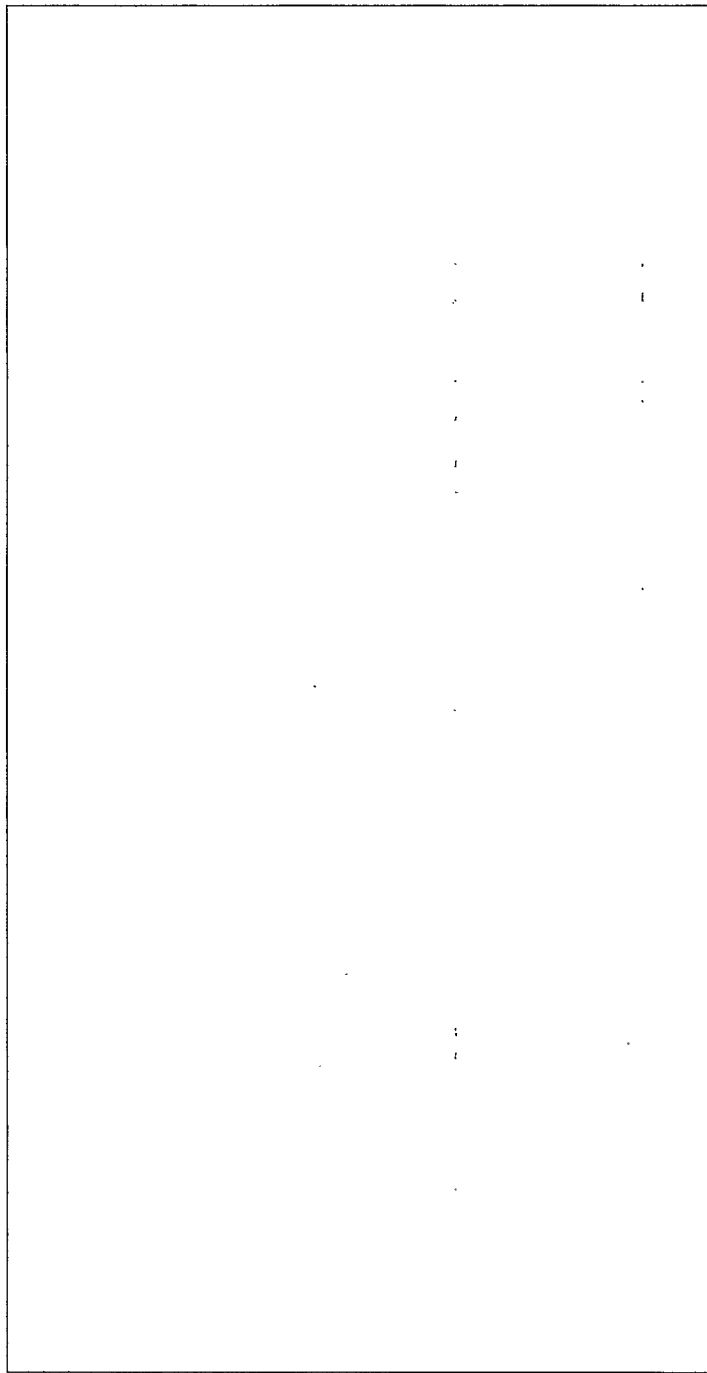
