DISCLOSURE MADE, COURT COULD RECESS OR TRIAL COULD CONTINUE WITH OTHER EVIDENCE WHILE COURT AWAITS ANALYSIS OF DOCUMENTS. SIMULTANEOUS WITH PUBLIC DISCLOSURE AT TRIAL GOB COULD. THROUGH DIPLOMATIC CHANNELS, INFORM MEMBERS OF OAS OF ITS INTENTION TO PRESENT CASE OF CUBAN INTERVENTION BASED ON DOCUMENTS AND INVITE OAR'S TO SUPPLY CORROBORATING EVALUATION FROM THEIR OWN RESOURCES. ALSO WE BELIVE GOB SHOULD ANNOUNCE FUBLICILY ITS REQUEST TO FRIENDLY GOVERNMENTS TO PROVIDE EVALUATION AND CORROBORATION.

2. SUGGEST YOU URGE GOB IMMEDIATELY TO PRESENT DOCUMENTS IN DEBRAY TRIAL STRESSING THE NEED FOR PUBLIC REVELATION 30 THAT THE U.S. AND OTHER OAS GOVERNMENTS CAN EFFECTIVELY RROVIDE SUPPORTING INFORMATION AT 12 MFM. IF GUESTION OF U.S. EVALUATION RAISED YOU CAN REPLY ALONG LINES OF PARAGRAPHS 2 AND 3 OF DEFTEL 35603. BECAUSE TIME SO SHORT DEPARTMENT INTENDS CONTACT SANJINES AND DIEZ DE MEDINA AND ASK THEM TO URGE SIMILAR ACTION ON 3008.
