Lately, while cleaning out my files and desk, getting ready for my retirement in January, I came across something I've been keeping as an object lesson for more than a quarter century.



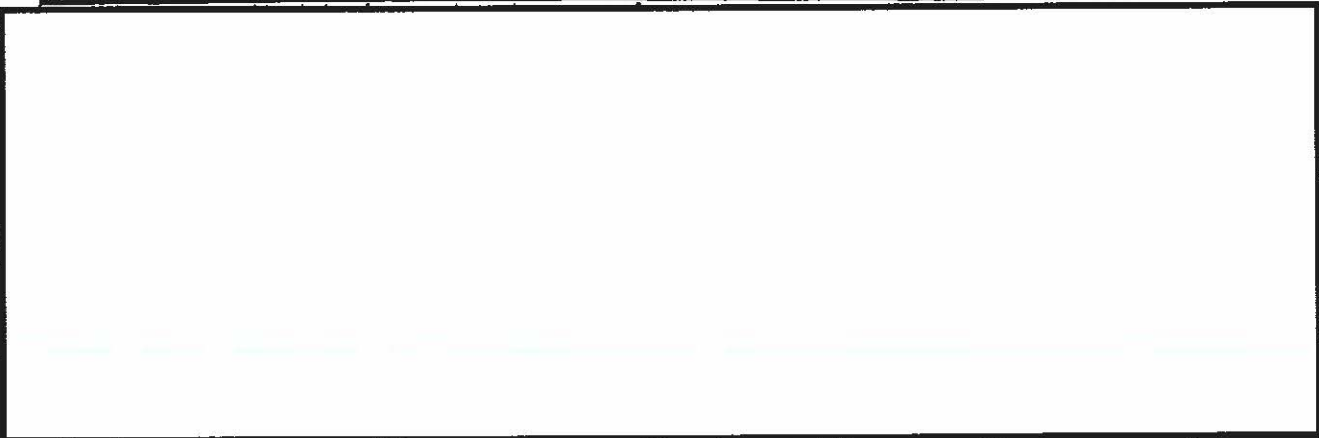
