- 5. IN ADDITION TO THE RADIO FREQUENCY JAMMING CAUSED BY TUMS, THE POSSIBILITY OF TUMS CREATING A HEALTH HAZARD HAS ALSO BEEN INVESTIGATED. THE RESULTS OF OUR INVESTIGATIONS IN 1967 (PROJECT PANDORA) HAVE BEEN NEGATIVE IN THAT THE TUMS POWER LEVEL IS WELL BELOW CURRENT U.S. SAFETY STANDARDS. IF MEASUREMENT OF THE MUTS SIGNAL SHOWS THE POWER LEVEL TO BE ABOVE SOVIET SAFETY STANDARDS, WHICH ARE LOWER THAN U.S. STANDARDS, A PROTEST TO THE SOVIETS SHOULD BE CONSIDERED AT SECRETARY-DOBRYNIN OR AMBASSADOR-GROMYKO LEVEL. WE RECALL THAT PROTESTS WERE MADE IN PAST YEARS RE TUMS AND THAT SOVIETS (GROMYKO) IN ONE INSTANCE COUNTERED THAT MORE INTENSIVE SIGNALS WERE DIRECTOED AGAINST SOVIET EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON. SUGGEST THAT IT WOULD BE ADVISABLE TO CHECK ON THIS SITUATION, WHICH WOULD BE FACTOR IN ANY RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING A PROTEST WHICH MAY BE INDICATED.
